Seven students from Daugai Technology and Business School completed a two-week internship in the cities of Nowy Sącz and Grybów (Poland). The students, specializing in Nursing Assistant, Vehicle Repair, and Accounting, gained knowledge and improved their practical skills in host organizations.



The Nursing Assistant students were pleased to have the opportunity to improve their existing practical skills and to see what the everyday work of nurses looks like in another country. They noted that although the field of nursing and social services in Lithuania is improving every year, there is still room for growth when compared with the experience they gained in Poland.

The students who carried out their internship in a car repair workshop successfully demonstrated their practical skills. They quickly earned the trust of the workshop staff through their diligence and eagerness to learn.

The Accounting student became familiar with the Polish accounting system: how institutions manage fixed assets and inventory, how purchases and sales are documented, how accounting registers are filled out, carried out document error checks, and explored the accounting software used in the company.



The internships in Poland were carried out as part of the Erasmus+ project No. 2024-1-LT01-KA121-VET-000226077.

In 2022, Daugai Technology and Business School received Erasmus+ accreditation, valid until December 31, 2027. This means that mobility activities abroad will continue until the end of 2027.
