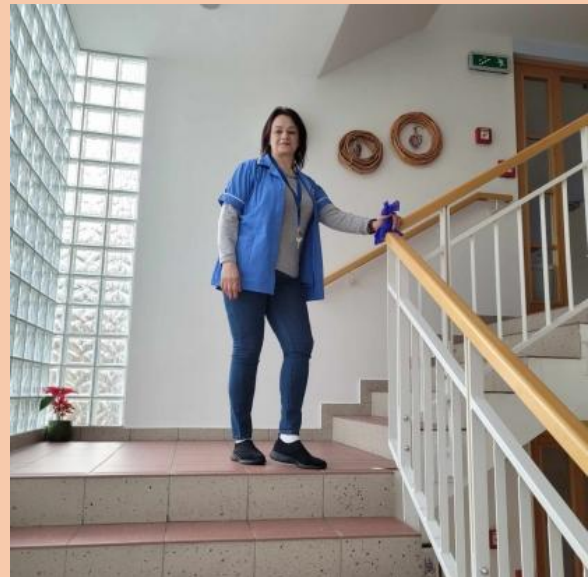


In their free time, the students had the opportunity to explore the beautiful city of Prague and admire its stunning architecture.
